CRM-22176-2022

This is an application filed under Rule 3-A (1) Chapter VI,
Part-B, Volume V of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders
for grant of leave to file the present petition.

In view of the averments made in the application, the same is
allowed and leave is granted under the aforesaid Rule and Order to file the
present petition.

CRM-22178-2022 and Main case

CRM-22178-2022 is an application filed under Section 482
Cr.P.C. for withdrawing the main petition.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioners has submitted
that the main case is fixed for hearing on 13.09.2022 and states that the
same be pre-poned today as the petitioner seeks to withdraw the main case

in view of the compromise effected between the parties on 16.05.2022. It is further submitted that the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise has already been filed and the same is now pending for 17.10.2022.

Learned State counsel has submitted that he has no objection in case the main case is pre-poned today itself as the same is sought to be withdrawn.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, main case is preponed from 13.09.2022 to today itself.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 42 dated 25.02.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Women Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been compromised and thus, she seeks to withdraw the main petition and for the said purpose, CRM-22178-2022 has also been filed. The said application is supported by an affidavit of both petitioners.

Learned State counsel has submitted that he has no objection in case the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the application bearing CRM-22178-2022 is allowed and the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
