SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the detenue namely Shaunu Kumar, who was stated to be in illegal detention of respondent No.4.

In para 2 of the reply dated 29.08.2022 filed by the State pursuant to notice of motion issued on 24.08.2022 it has been stated that a case bearing FIR No. 20, dated 16.08.2022, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC has been registered against the husband of the petitioner at Police Station Cyber Crime, Chandigarh and he was arrested on 20.08.2022 in the said FIR. Copy of the arrest memo is attached with the reply as Annexure R-4/2. It has further been mentioned in the reply that the petitioner has concealed the afore-said material fact from this Court and the present petition deserves to be dismissed on this ground alone.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to justify the reasons for filing the present petition, however, he prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
