The petitioner has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.160 dated 22.08.2021 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

On 07.10.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that victim-Gurdip Singh was already married with complainant Jaspreet Kaur and the alleged occurrence took place at the house of the victim, where his parents were also present. He submits that the complainant was not present at the place of occurrence and was residing with her parents and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case, as there is nothing to indicate the involvement of the petitioner in the crime, much less the abetment to suicide.

Notice of motion for 21.01.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Binder Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 07.10.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the interim order dated 07.10.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

This petition stands disposed off.
