The grievance of the petitioners is that after having been brought on the merit list and being allowed to join and complete their training, the merit list was revised and the petitioners were shown on the waiting list.

As per the reply filed, initially the petitioners were successful and were on the merit list prepared. On account of their merit, appointment letters were issued to them and they were directed to join the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali and were further sent for basic training course at Commando Training Centre, Bahadurgarh, Patiala. On successful completion of the said training, they were posted at Police Station, Lalru and Police Station, Dera Bassi respectively. On account of litigation that was initiated by the other unsuccessful candidates, the merit list was subsequently revised and the names of the petitioners came to be down in the revised merit list and they were shown to be on the waiting list. The same was challenged

before this Court by way of filing the instant writ petition.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners today.

Learned State counsel would place on record communication dated 29.09.2022, as addressed by the Director General of Police, Punjab to the Advocate General, Punjab, which would reflect that petitioner No.1-Sukhchain Kaur with total of 27 marks and petitioner No.2-Sompal Kaur with total of 26 marks have now been selected against the vacant seats of Ex-Servicemen SC (R&O) Female and of Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B). Petitioner No.1-Sukhchain Kaur figures at serial No.20 in the merit list of Ex-Servicemen SC (R&O) Female category and petitioner No.2-Sompal Kaur figures at serial No.24 in the merit list of Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B) Female category.

In view of the aforesaid communication dated 29.09.2022, the instant writ petition is disposed of, leaving it open to the petitioners to file afresh, should any cause of action still survived.
