Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.68, dated 23.6.2021, registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station Meharban, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Notice was issued in this case and the State was directed to file status report as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh submits that the victim in this case is minor and till date she has not been recovered. Despite number of opportunities granted, the fact regarding the victim not being recovered remains the same till date. There are specific allegations against the petitioner regarding committing the alleged offence.

In view of the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the present case requires a thorough and fair investigation. In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the opinion that no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out, hence, the same is dismissed.
