Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-University submits that the claim of the petitioner was forwarded to the Government as the approval of the Government is needed in the cases which involves financial liability and the Government has not responded back with regard to the approval so far, due to which, the claim of the petitioner for the grant of step up of his pay could not be granted.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the Government has not responded to the request of the University so far, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and the decision so taken will be intimated to the respondent-University.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that in case an approval is received from the State Government, pensionary benefits of the petitioner will be released to him within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the approval from the State Government. In case, the request is declined, the said aspect will also be intimated to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the stand of the respondents, the present petition may be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the action taken by the respondents, the petitioner will avail appropriate remedy available with him for the redressal of his grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
