[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to file an application under Order 39 Rule 2-A CPC before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul in respect of order (Annexure P-5) dated 06.08.2022 and the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul, be directed to decide the application to be filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rule 2-A CPC in respect of order (Annexure P-5) dated 06.08.2022 as also the applications (Annexures P-2 & P-4) dated 05.07.2022 and 22.07.2022 expeditiously.

[2] In the light of the position noted above, the instant petition is dismissed as *withdrawn* with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul qua order (Annexures P-5) dated 06.08.2022 as well as the representations stated to have been filed by the petitioner. In case of

receipt of any application in respect thereto, the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul, is directed to consider and decide the same as also applications (Annexures P-2 & P-4) dated 05.07.2022 and 22.07.2022 in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
