The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 28 dated 02.02.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 09.05.2022, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran and got their statements recorded. Report dated 21.05.2022 has been received whereby after

satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntarily and without pressure.

I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged, are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioner.

Resultantly, FIR No. 28 dated 02.02.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
