The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ, order or direction to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner are five brothers including the petitioner and two out of the five brothers have dispute with the three brothers including the petitioner and they have dragged the petitioner and beaten him and for that purpose, a complaint was given to the police but no action has been taken in this regard.

At this stage, Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has stated on instructions from HC Tirath Singh that

when the fight took place between the brothers, the proceedings under Section 107 and 150 Cr.P.C were initiated vide Rapat No.37 dated 09.08.2022.

Mr. P.K.S. Phoolka, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, he does not wish to press the present petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same but he may be granted liberty to approach the appropriate forum/Court for the purpose of redressal of his grievances in accordance with law by filing a criminal complaint or any other remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
