Prayer made in the present petition is for extension of parole by 8 weeks which had been granted to the petitioner also for 8 weeks under the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 (Annexure P-4).

The petitioner was to surrender today i.e. on 02.09.2022. The extension has been sought on the ground that the mother of the petitioner is unwell having heart problem and is aged 70 years. Vide order dated 31.08.2022, we had asked the State to confirm the factum of medical treatment as such which she is undergoing.

The State has filed the response regarding the same through the concerned police official ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana. It has been stated that the petitioner's mother is undergoing treatment and it has also been confirmed that the petitioner's mother is a heart patient and was operated earlier also but now the same problem has again arisen.

Keeping in view the above, we are of the considered opinion that the period of parole is liable to be extended on interim basis for a period of 4 weeks so as to get her treated appropriately.

Accordingly, the petitioner shall surrender on 01.10.2022 at 10.00 a.m. with the concerned jail authorities.

The petition is disposed of in view of the above directions.
