The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution read with Section 4 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, for grant of parole to the petitioner for a period of one week, enabling him to attend the first *Barsi* (death anniversary) of his father, which is scheduled to be fixed for 29.08.2022, and to make necessary arrangements for the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is undergoing life imprisonment in case bearing FIR No.258 dated 01.09.2019, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, under Sections 302, 34 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

He further contends that unfortunately, the father of the petitioner expired on 08.09.2021, and that the first *Barsi* (death

anniversary) of his father is scheduled to be fixed for 29.08.2022 and that the petitioner being the only son of the deceased, is to make necessary arrangements and to perform certain rituals for the *Barsi* of his father.

On the other hand, learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the *Barsi* (death anniversary) of the father of the petitioner is scheduled to be fixed for 29.08.2022.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts as well as the submissions as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole on 27.08.2022 for a period of one week, subject to his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jail authorities, after expiry of the parole period.
