The instant Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to withdraw the Look Out Circular issued pursuant to letter dated 24.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) written by respondent no.3 to respondent No.4 in case bearing FIR No. 61 dated 14.07.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, Ambala and further prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the letter dated 24.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) and look out circular issued in pursuant to the said letter and further prayer to issue in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents No.1 and 3 to produce all the records pertaining to letter dated 24.12.2021 and look out circular issued in pursuant to the said letter and also to stay the letter dated 24.12.2021

and look out circular issued in pursuant to the said letter against the petitioner.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that an anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner arising out of the same FIR is already pending before a Coordinate Bench of this Court. Consequently, he seeks permission to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file an appropriate Criminal Miscellaneous petition for seeking the same relief which is undisputedly an efficacious alternative remedy available to the petitioner against the same order.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
