1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.11.2018, in CWP No.2158-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 30.11.2018, reveals that CWP No.2158-2018, was disposed of by directing the respondent that in case the petitioners sent a fresh copy of the legal notice/representation to the concerned authorities along with copy of the order, a speaking order be passed in the matter by the competent authority at the earliest, and in any case not later than six weeks and if any amount was found payable to the petitioners, the same be released to the petitioners after obtaining sanction from the Finance Department, if required.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that

claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 13.01.2016, has been decided and payment as per entitlement therein released to the petitioners, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
