As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹32,00,000/- (₹ Thirty Two Lac Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per statement of learned counsel for the appellants, out of the enhanced amount of ₹32,00,000/-, ₹10,50,000/- each be paid to appellant Nos.1 and 2 and ₹11,00,000/- be paid to appellant No.3.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques for ₹10,50,000/- each in favour of appellant Nos. 1 and 2, namely, Vipin Garg and Varun Garg, both sons of late Shri Pawan Kumar and one crossed-cheque for ₹11,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.3 – Priti Garg daughter of Pawan Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.08.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s)

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may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and
file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
