The present petition has been filed for issuing directions to respondent No.2 to transfer the enquiry of the FIR bearing No.64 dated 11.06.2022, registered at Police Station Dehlon, Distt. Ludhiana under Sections 420 & 406 IPC.

Notice served upon the official respondents through State's counsel. No notices are required to issue to the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case direction be issued to respondent No.2, to decide the representation dated 11.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.2- Director Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Police Head Quarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) either himself or by authorizing any officer not below the rank of IPC cadre, by passing a speaking and reasoned order ***within 30 working days from today.***

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
