RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus for setting aside the order dated 10.01.2011 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1 on the application instituted by respondent No.2 and for setting aside the ex-parte award dated 10.06.2002 (Anneuxre P-1) and all the consequential orders and proceedings arising therefrom.

It has been pointed by the counsel for the parties that during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have arrived at amicable settlement, wherein respondent No.2 has agreed to pay a total amount of Rs.3.25 Lakhs qua the full and final settlement of the claim of the petitioner.

The said offer is acceptable to the petitioner.

Hence, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to make the payment of Rs.3.25 Lakhs to the petitioner. This amount shall include the amount of Rs.2.50 Lakhs which already stands deposited with the Executing Court as per the order dated 02.06.2017 passed by this Court in LPA No.1002 of 2017. The Executing Court is directed to release the said amount to the petitioner. The balance amount of Rs.75,000/- is directed to be paid to the petitioner through demand draft in his name, within a period of two weeks from today.

With this settlement between the parties, all litigation pending between the parties regarding the claim involved in the present petition or any proceedings ancillary or connected thereto, are also ordered to be terminated. The concerned Court/Forum shall pass the necessary and consequential orders ending the said proceedings.

Disposed of in the above terms.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of as such.
