Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 20.08.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A, 495, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana Punjab.

Vide order dated 08.10.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.10.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner tooth and nail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.10.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
