Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondents No. 6 and 7 is taken on record.

Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent No. 3 who are harassing him at the behest of respondents No. 4 to 7.

Upon notice, short reply dated 13.09.2022 by way of affidavit of Sh. Palwinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division City, District Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, has been filed.

As per the said reply, there is no danger to life and liberty of

the petitioner at the hands of private respondents. The SHO, Police Station City, Hoshiarpur, has instructed the duty officers as well as the officials of PCR unit, to keep vigil on the house of the petitioner to avoid any untoward incident with the petitioner.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed. Therefore, no further action is required to be taken in the instant petition and the same stands disposed of, accordingly.
