This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents to decide written complaint dated 06.08.2022, in which, primarily the prayer which has been made is for registration of FIR against the private respondents.

After arguing for some time and faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others**, reported as **2008 (2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S.
