Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 22.08.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Vide order dated 07.02.2022, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
