AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking quashing of orders dated 27.4.2021 and 28.9.2021 whereby permission was given to take voice samples of the petitioner in FIR No. 360 dated 20.8.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 474, 198, 201 and 120-B IPC (Sections 12(1)(B) of the Passport Act, and Sections 7, 8, 12 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and 66-C and 66-D of the IT Act added later on), registered at Police Station City Tohana.

Since the filing of the petition, none put in appearance of the petitioner on three dates and on one date, the matter was adjourned on request of the petitioner.

Today, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State has filed status report dated 1.5.2022. Paragraph 4 of the status report is quoted below:

“4. That on 18.4.2022 the learned court ASJ Fatehabad directed accused Surbir Singh to accompany the police for voice sampling on 28.4.2022. Consequently he appeared before the Director FSL Madhuban and his voice sampling has been taken.”

In view of the status report filed, as voice samples have already been taken, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
