The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Vide this petition, the petitioner is seeking cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to the respondents in terms of order dated 17.07.2019 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana (Annexure P-5).

On the previous date of hearing, i.e. 06.08.2021, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Ludhiana. The report which is on record indicates that the matter was amicably settled between the parties and the petitioner and respondent No.1 had agreed to dissolve their marriage by mutual consent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per his

instructions, the petitioner and respondent No.1 have now started residing

together and as such, the petitioner does not want to proceed with the present petition, so she may be permitted to withdraw the same.
