The petitioner, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of Law, had impugned the advertisement No.25/2022 for the said posts on the ground of non-disclosure of the marks obtained by her in the online test.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been disclosed the marks obtained by her in the online examination and the candidates have been called for interview for the said post.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. A.S. Virk, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1/University and submits that the online test was one of the components of the examination for the post of Assistant Professor. 40% was the minimum qualifying marks in the online test. The petitioner had obtained 58 marks out of 200 which is below 40% and therefore, she was not shortlisted for the other tests.

Heard.

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The petitioner, after having participated in the examination and not obtained the qualifying marks in the online examination, has challenged the advertisement. Even otherwise, the petitioner has not been able to point out any flaw in the advertisement which would warrant interference while exercising writ jurisdiction. As the petitioner has secured less than 40% marks, she has not been shortlisted for further tests.

Consequently, I do not find any merit in this petition which stands dismissed.
