Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners have been appointed on the post of Sweepers but the petitioners are also being made to work as a Chowkidar which is beyond their duties prescribed as a Sweeper. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the ladies are being asked to work as Chowkidar at night, which is otherwise not permissible and therefore, the respondents are under an obligation to only ask the petitioners to perform the duties for which they have been appointed for and are being paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioners in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director Elementary/Secondary Education Haryana Shiksha Sadan Sector-5, Panchkula to decide the legal notice dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
