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MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner herein seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty, while averring that he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 to 19, as these respondents want to illegally/forcibly take/grab the possession of the land as well as the premises of Dera Santgarh in Village Mataur, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, as owned by his Sect. It has also been mentioned in the petition that a representation (Annexure P-5) as well as the reminder (Annexure P-6) in respect of the same, have already been sent to respondent No.4 in this regard but in vain.

Mr. Arun Gupta, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in this case in pursuance

of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restrict their prayer to the issuance of a direction to respondent No.4 to look into and take appropriate action on the said representation of the petitioner, i.e. Annexure P-5.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the present matter, respondent No.4-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, is hereby directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and if the petitioner is found to be genuinely deserving the protection of his life and liberty, then to take appropriate action strictly in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
