Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.450 dated 02.10.2020 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 12(1)B of Passport Act, 1967, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 29.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the case of the applicant/petitioner similar to the co-accused, who has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the State states that prima facie the case of the petitioner is similar to the co-accused, however, the petitioner is yet to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 25.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Surender Kumar states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.11.2021 is made absolute.
