PANKAJ JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.217 dated 18.10.2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 324, 341, 506 and 34 of IPC at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation is complete. Challan already stands presented. Moreover, the parties have now reconciled their differences and reached a compromise. A copy thereof has been placed on record as Annexure P-2.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is the one who gave life threatening injury to the victim on his head. Khanda has been recovered pursuant to the disclosure statement suffered by the petitioner. Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, the petitioner will not be entitled to bail at this stage.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the case.

5. Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the fact that the petitioner has already undergone incarceration for 07 months and 19 days. Investigation stands concluded and as per the petitioner, now the parties have reconciled their differences. Co-accused has already been admitted to regular bail by the trial Court.

6. Keeping in view the cumulative effect of the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

7. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
