On 30th of August, 2022, following order was passed :-

“Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.111 dated 25.06.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections 407, 411, 285 and 34 IPC, 1860 and Sections 4 and 5 of Explosives Substances Act, 1908 registered at Police Station Pasyana, District Patiala, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia relies upon the order dated 05.08.2022 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **Kaisar alias Sonu Vs. State of Punjab, CRM-M-34469 of 2022** whereby the co-accused of the petitioner i.e. Kaisar alias Sonu has been extended the concession of interim bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, Asstt. A.G., Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail in the same terms subject to the same conditions as in the case of **Kaisar alias Sonu Vs. State of Punjab CRM-M-34469- 2022**. To come up on 07.12.2022

2. Today, Ld. State Counsel on instructions from SI Navdeep Chahal submits that the petitioner has already joined investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

3. In the circumstances, the order dated 30th of August, 2022 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Sections 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

4. The petitions stands disposed off.
