The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for the issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents No.4 and 5 to stop sending their recovery agents to the house of the petitioner and causing unnecessary harassment/mental torture to the petitioner with the help of respondent No.3 for recovering the Truck ECOMET registration NO. HR64-A-7725 which has already been seized by the police officials in connection with case bearing FIR No. 232 dated 18.05.2020 at Police Station Maigal Gang, District Lakhimpur Kheri, U.P.

After arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to them in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
