[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 26.07.2022 in CWP No.16095 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.16095 of 2022 it was ordered to be heard along with CWP No.12092 of 2022 with same interim order as in said petition whereas perusal of order dated 30.05.2022 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.12092 of 2022, it was directed that in the meantime, the petitioners would be issued provisional certificates subject to verification of their participation in the tournaments organized by the Haryana Olympic Association.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that needful having been done in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.07.2022

and the petitioners issued provisional certificates on verification of their

participation in the tournaments organized by the Haryana Olympic Association, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
