Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.111 dated 30.07.2021 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 01.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel contends that the injuries allegedly suffered by the victim punishable under Section 326 IPC are attributed to the coaccused, who has been released on regular bail. He further submits that the petitioner had allegedly caused two injuries which are punishable under Section 324 IPC.

Adjourned to 22.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance

cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Amarjit Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.11.2021 is made absolute.
