On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellant contends that in the light of the stay of the impugned order of suspension by this Court vide order dated 29.08.2019, the appellant has completed her full term. That apart the basis for suspension was registration of an FIR against the appellant i.e. FIR No.3 dated 03.01.2019, which has been cancelled after the cancellation report was approved by the concerned judicial Magistrate. He further contends that the only prayer which the appellant would press at this stage, would be that the order of suspension which is impugned in the present appeal may not be taken as an impediment for her future elections, if any, if decided to participate therein.

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Learned counsel for the State prays for an adjournment to verify the said factual assertions. Prayer is granted.

In pursuance to the said order, counsel for the State has acknowledged the said facts as has been mentioned therein and it has also been informed that the election has already been held, where the appellant did not participate. This aspect has not been disputed by the counsel for the appellant.

Counsel for the State has also informed that the suspension period of the appellant is to expire on 09.02.2024.

In the light of the reasons recorded in the order dated dated 29.08.2022, it is for the purpose of clarification stated that the order of suspension would not be an impediment for the appellant to participate in the elections in future.

The appeal stands disposed of in above terms.

In the light of the disposal of main appeal, CM-3098-LPA-2019 is disposed of as infructuous.
