This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 for taking necessary and appropriate legal action against respondents No.5 to 8 for committing theft by snatching and for attacking the petitioners and causing injuries to them as well as for outraging the modesty of the petitioners as the police of P.S. Sadar, Kapurthala have failed to act against respondents No.5 to 8, with further direction to act upon complaint/representation dated 25.06.2022 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have moved a complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and no decision on the same has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4- State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, Deputy

Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the complaint/representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and take an appropriate action as per law preferably within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
