[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 25.05.2022 in CRM-M No.22909 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.22909 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent herein to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG has filed compliance report dated 12.09.2022 along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 09.09.2022 rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 09.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
