PANKAJ JAIN, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4. As per petitioners, they have married on 09.07.2022 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who happen to be the relatives of petitioner No.1 i.e. Usha Devi.

5. Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major stating that petitioner No.1-Usha Devi is 06.08.2000 born and petitioner No.2-Tarur Kumar is 19.02.1989 born as per their Aadhar Cards.

6. Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Panchkula to consider the representation dated 16.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioners.

7. Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 7 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

8. The petition stands disposed off.
