The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.215 dated 31.10.2020 under Sections 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 and further added Section 307 IPC in which he was released on anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa (Section 326 and 201 IPC have been added later on) registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 30.08.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 30.08.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 30.08.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
