Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-837-2021, titled as “Shriram Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and another”, dated 19.07.2021, the petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The writ petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“Keeping in view the limited relief claimed by learned counsel for the petitioners, without commenting on the merits or the rights of the petitioners and in view of the communication dated 19.03.2021 placed on record, which shows that respondent No.2, while referring to the pendency of the present petition, has called for the record of the petitioners. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners within two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.”

In reply, it has been stated that in accordance with the directions, a speaking order dated 14.10.2021, has already been passed.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
