1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 22.08.2017, in CWP No.8018 of 2001.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 22.08.2017, reveals that CWP No.8018 of 2001, was disposed of and condition in the impugned order to the extent that the petitioner would not be entitled to pay and allowances of the post of Superintendent Grade-I, for which he had been given current duty charge was quashed and the petitioner was held entitled to pay admissible to the post of Superintendent Grade-I, during the period he worked as such with arrears to be calculated and paid to him within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, states that LPA filed against the order of the writ Court was dismissed likewise SLP (C) No.6147 of 2007

Addl. AG, Punjab, refers to communication dated 25.05.2022, from the Treasury Officer, Punjab, Chandigarh to the Deputy Director (Administration)-cum-Chief Engineer (Headquarter) of payment of Rs.12,523/- having been made on account of arrears of revision of DCRG to the petitioner and further on instructions from Mr. Arun Kumar, Senior Assistant, O/o Chief Engineer, Head Quarters Water Resources Department, Punjab, states that payment on account of revision of pension would be credited in the account of the petitioner within 15 days from today by the Punjab National Bank.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondents to ensure adherence to the assurance given through the learned Addl. AG, Punjab and to credit the amount on account of revision of pension in the bank account of the petitioner within 15 days from today. It is, however, made clear that the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in case needful is not done within the stipulated period of time.
