The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C read with section 482 Cr.P.C praying for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of 4 weeks in case FIR No.105 dated 14.2.2022 registered under sections 365, 376(3), 506 IPC and section 6 of POCSO Act (later on added sections 75 and 84 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, at Police Station, Kharkhoda, district Sonipat on the ground that medical condition of the wife of the petitioner is not well.

State was directed to file a status report to verify the factum of medical condition of the wife of the petitioner. The same has been filed by way of affidavit of Dr. Mayank Gupta, IPS, A.S.P., Kharkhoda, Sonipat.

It has been mentioned that on verification wife of the petitioner was found normal and she was duly discharged after two days of her admission and hence nothing abnormal has been found in the medical condition of the wife of the petitioner.

In view of the above position, there is no merit in the present petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
