VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.134 dated 11.07.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 of IPC and Sections 24, 54, 59 of the Arms Act have been added later on) at Police Station Shahkot, Jalandhar Rural District Jalandhar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 19.11.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to issue notice of motion and also directed the parties to get their statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court in support of the compromise. However, the parties had not appeared before the trial Court in

order to get their statements recorded. Thereafter, on 27.05.2022, this Court had granted another opportunity to the parties to get their statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court. As per report submitted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, the parties had again not appeared to get their statements recorded.

In view of the above, it is apparent that the compromise has not fructified and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition, in case, the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get their statements recorded before the trial Court with respect to compromise effected between them.
