Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 64 days
in filing the present appeal.

It has been stated that the applicant-appellants were under the
impression that for the purpose of limitation, the period of summer
vacations would be excluded and, therefore, contacted the counsel in the
month of August for the purpose of filing the present appeal. It has further
been stated that the delay in filing the appeal neither intentional nor
deliberate.

In view of the above, the present application which is supported
by the affidavit of applicant/appellant No.1, is allowed.

Delay of 64 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

LPA No.755 of 2022

Challenge in this appeal is to the judgment dated 30.05.2022
passed by the learned Single Judge, whereby writ petition preferred by the
appellants has been dismissed along with three other writ petitions.

The said judgment was a subject matter of appeal in *LPA No.642 of 2022* titled as *Chandni and others Versus State of Punjab and another*, which was considered by a Division Bench of this Court and dismissed vide judgment dated 04.08.2022. The same pleas and grounds have been taken herein as were pressed in the said appeal. No new plea or ground has been argued by the counsel for the appellants.

3. The present appeal is, therefore, dismissed in same terms as LPA No.642 of 2022.

4. In the light of the dismissal of the appeal, CM No.1811-LPA of 2022 also stands disposed of.
