Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.65 dated 21.5.2021 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station New Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties vide settlement deed Annexure P-2 and the entire settled amount has already been paid to the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the petitioner has not come to the Court with clean hands as he has already been declared PO vide order dated 23.11.2021 passed by the Court of JMIC, Jalandhar.

Mr. Sandeep Arora, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has not disputed the fact of compromise and further submits that the entire settled amount has been received by the complainant.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner made prayer that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender and seek regular bail from the Court concerned and the same be decided in a time bound manner by the said Court.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender and to apply for regular bail before the Court concerned and the same is to be decided within 3 days of its presentation in accordance with law.
