MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.184 dated 31.07.2021 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341, 506, 504, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 08.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the injury inviting the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC suffered by injured Ridhik Kanojia (complainant) is attributed to co-accused Charry Walia. He submits that the petitioner is accused of causing simple injury to injured Mannu Sharma. He further submits that in all, there are nine accused and seven were granted the concession of pre arrest bail by the Court of Sessions and pre arrest bail of co-accused Charry Walia already stands dismissed.

Notice of motion for 03.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and

in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Jaspal states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.11.2021 is made absolute.
