Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing the impugned order dated 31.07.2019 (P-5), whereby petitioner was ordered to be posted for two days of week i.e. Monday and Friday at Mansa and remaining three days at Head Office during her extension period.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Vikram Jain, Junior Assistant, Forest Department, Sangrur has apprised the Court that as on today, petitioner is not in service as after attaining the age of superannuation, she retired from service w.e.f. 30.04.2020.

In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.

Needless to say that in case petitioner still feels dissatisfied, she would be at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months for revival of this petition and same shall be considered as per law.
