Present petition has been filed for the grant of the pensionary benefits to the petitioner, who has retired on 31.05.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioner but the same have been with incorrect calculations and therefore, the grievance of the petitioner still survives.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation pointing out the discrepancy in calculations so that the same could be rectified and the petitioner be paid the actual emoluments for which he is entitled for along with the interest for the delay, which has been caused.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner pointing out any discrepancy in the calculation or the claim for the grant of interest, the said representation will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate orders will be passed within a period of eight weeks and after the decision of the representation in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary relief, the same will also be released to the petitioner within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for respondent No.3, no further

grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such with liberty as prayed for.
