These two petitions are filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.111 dated 8.6.2021, under Sections 22-C/61 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sirhind.

The brief facts are that the petitioners were apprehended by the police party on 8.6.2021, while they were riding on a motor cycle bearing registration No.PB-10-HJ-1880. From a bag kept between the two petitioners, 4200 tablets of Ultradal containing Tramadol Salt were recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the recovery was marginally higher than the commercial quantity. Seals put on the seized contraband were changed.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer, submits that seals were found intact by the SHO and also when the samples were produced before Magistrate. He submits that recovery comes to 1.486 kilograms.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petitions at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
