AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This writ petition in the nature of mandamus was filed seeking directions to the official respondents (arrayed in the petition) to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents.

From the pleadings, it is apparent that there is a dispute between daughter-in-law and her in-laws. Representation dated 6.9.2021 was filed with the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

The State has filed a reply pleading that the dispute is with regard to the property and the matter is being enquired into.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI-Sukhraj Singh submits that the representation would be considered and decided within three weeks from today and copy of the decision would be supplied to the petitioner.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievances, if any.
