MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0044 dated 20.02.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 26.08.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the deal with father of petitioner, vide agreement dated 9.4.2018, petitioner was not party to the agreement and has been falsely implicated in this case.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.K. Banga, Advocate, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of complainant and submits that payment, vide above agreement, was deposited in the joint account of parties.

List on 20.11.2019.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his

furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Ishwar Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.08.2019 is made absolute.
