Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing an agenda item (7i) of the 42nd CGST Council meeting pertaining to deliberations held on 5th and 12th October, 2020.

The grievance put forth by counsel is that the ayurveda sanitizer ingredients has been kept under tariff item 38089400 with 18% GST instead of 12%.

Having heard counsel at length and having perused the pleadings on record, we are of the view that no interference at this stage is warranted.

Pursuant to the decision taken in the agenda item in question, a show cause notice is stated to have been issued to the members of the petitioner/association. Such show cause notice even though not under challenge in the instant petition ought to be responded to and which would lead to an adjudication in the matter.

In view of the above and without making any observations on the merit, writ petition is disposed of.
