Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to lapse of time, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the only grievance of the petitioners, which is left to be addressed is that the petitioners be paid salary according to their entitlement as per the instructions issued by the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation along with the evidence that the salary being paid to the petitioners is not according to their entitlement, is filed by the petitioners, the same will be looked into in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation and in case after the decision, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to them within a next four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents for the redressal of their grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
